



# USER MANUAL – INTERNAL VS. EXTERNAL ELECTIVES TARGET AUDIENCE: ADMINISTRATORS

### INTERNAL VS. EXTERNAL ELECTIVE ROTATIONS

There are two types of elective rotations:

## **Internal Elective**

- An elective rotation that takes place within the McMaster catchment (ex. Hamilton Hospitals, MacCARE regions).
- Rotations are scheduled the same as any core rotation with the exception of the format being updated to elective.
- These rotations have hospital funding attached and the preceptors teaching are eligible for both payment and contribution credit by McMaster.

## **External Elective**

- An elective rotation that takes place outside of the McMaster catchment (ex. Toronto, other provinces, international)
- All external electives are represented in the schedule by using the generic 'Elective' rotation.
- These rotations are <u>not</u> funded and preceptors are awarded funding or teaching credit through McMaster.

#### **Example:**
