Updating EPA and Stage Status

It is important that each trainee's EPA dashboard is kept up to date and has accurate EPA and stage statuses. This will help the trainee, academic coach and competence committee members review the dashboard more efficiently. Program Directors, Program Administrators and Competence Committee members have access to update EPA and Stage statuses.

1. When the Competence Committee has decided an EPA or stage is Achieved, under the Actions button, update the status to Achieved.
