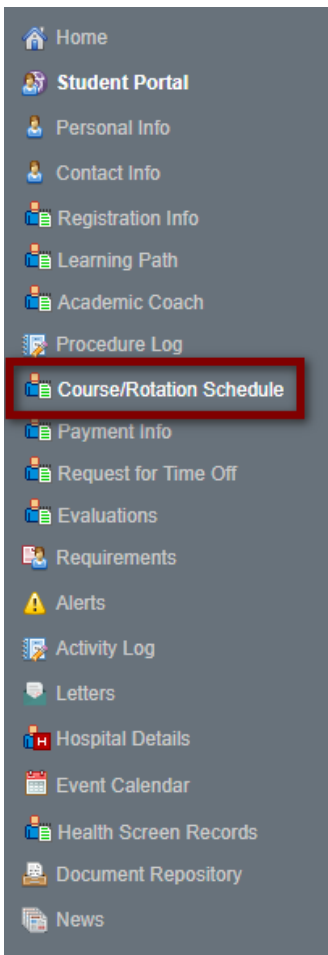

Viewing the Current Course/Rotation Schedule

Rotation schedules are entered by the Program at the beginning of the academic year. Your schedule is subject to change, so it is important to check it often.

To view your rotation schedule, click on “Course/Rotation Schedule” on the left-hand side of the screen:



The Rotation Schedule will include the name of the course/rotation, course/rotation type, program, location, format, training level, block (fall/winter/spring summer), start date, end date, and the supervisors scheduled.


